### **APPLICATION FOR ELECTROLOGIST**

#### **INSTRUCTION TO APPLICANTS**

**A. LICENSE BY EXAMINATION: Applicants must submit the following:**

1. Complete Application
2. Application Fee of \$100.00 (Non-Refundable Processing Fee)
3. Verification of Education Form. Complete a course of study of at least 600 hours at a school of electrolysis approved by the director which meets or exceeds the standards set by the American Electrology Association. This form needs to be submitted directly from your school to the Office of Professional Regulation.
4. Once your application is approved the office will notify you of a date and time for you to take the IBEC exam.

**B. LICENSE BY ENDORSEMENT: Applicants must submit the following:**

1. Complete Application
2. Application Fee of \$100.00 (Non-Refundable Processing Fee)
3. Verification of Licensure in other jurisdictions, and In-Good Standing. Current license in good standing in another jurisdiction having requirements substantially equivalent to those in the State of Vermont. This form needs to be submitted directly from the state(s) and sent to the Office of Professional Regulation.

ELECTROLOGY OFFICES.**
