**STIPULATION AND CONSENT ORDER**

NOW COMES the State of Vermont through Robert H. Backus, State Prosecuting Attorney and Applicant Central Nails through owner Tu Le and counsel John Riley and enter into the following Stipulation and Consent Order.

**Statement of Facts**

1. On February 22, 2006 Tu Le, as owner of Central Nails, submitted an application for a Shop License for Central Nails.
2. By a letter dated February 27, 2006 the Board preliminarily denied the Shop License.
3. The Applicant has appealed that denial and the matter is set before the Board for a hearing on March 13, 2006

**Understandings**

4. The parties understand that the terms of this Stipulation and Consent Order are contingent upon review and acceptance by the Board and that if the Board rejects any portion the entire Stipulation and Consent Order shall be null and void.
5. The Applicant has read and reviewed this document fully and agrees that it contains the entire agreement between the parties.
6. This Stipulation and Consent Order is entered into voluntarily by the Applicant after the opportunity to consult with legal counsel. The Applicant has not been coerced by anyone into signing this Stipulation and Consent Order.
7. The Applicant is voluntarily waiving any right to a contested hearing before the Board.
8. The Applicant waives any right to appeal from the consent order entered pursuant to this Stipulation and Consent Order.

9. Applicant agrees that the Board may enter the Order set out below.

**CONSENT ORDER**

Based upon the above stipulation, it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

A. Once Applicant is otherwise eligible for a license a license shall be issued subject to the following conditions:

1) Applicant shall be subject to two unannounced inspections within one year of obtaining a license.

2) Applicant shall reimburse the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each inspection.

3) If any discrepancies are noted in the inspection a reinspection shall occur within 20 days.

4) Applicant shall reimburse the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists \$100.00 for each reinspection.

5) The State Prosecuting Attorney may, at his discretion, bring charges of unprofessional conduct for any discrepancies revealed by an inspection or reinspection.

B. This Stipulation and Consent Order is a matter of public record.

C. This Stipulation and Consent Order will remain part of the Respondent's licensing file and may be considered in any future disciplinary matter.

D. A violation of this order may be unprofessional conduct and grounds for disciplinary action.
