STIPULATION AND CONSENT ORDER

NOW COMES the State of Vermont through Prosecuting Attorney Robert H. Backus and the Respondent, William Canfield, in person, and enter into the following Stipulation and Consent Order.

Board Authority

1. The Vermont Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists has jurisdiction to investigate and adjudicate allegations of unprofessional conduct pursuant to 3 V.S.A. §129 and 129a; 26 V.S.A. Chapter 6; the Rules of the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists ("RBBC"); and the Rules of the Office of Professional Regulation.

Statement of Facts

2. The Respondent, William P. Canfield, is licensed as a Barber in the State of Vermont holding license number 005-0000519. This license was originally issued on or about January 1, 1974 and is currently set to expire on September 30, 2008.
3. At all times relevant, the Respondent was the owner of Hair Haven (the Shop), a barber shop located in Fair Haven, Vermont. The Respondent opened the Shop on or about September 3, 1976 and has been operating the Shop since that time.
4. Pursuant to 26 V.S.A. § 282, the State of Vermont has required barber shops to be licensed since approximately 1997. The Respondent was not aware that the Shop required licensure, therefore the Shop was not initially licensed until July 15, 2006.

Charges

5. The above acts, omissions and/or circumstances described above and detailed below, constitute unprofessional conduct in violation of 26 V.S.A. § 272(b) (No person who owns or controls a shop or school of barbering or cosmetology shall permit the practice of barbering or cosmetology unless the shop or school is registered in accordance with this chapter).

Understandings

6. The Respondent understands that the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists must review and accept the terms of the Order set forth below and that if the Board rejects all or any portion of the Order, then this entire document shall be null and void.
7. The Respondent has read and reviewed this entire document and agrees that it contains the entire agreement between the parties.
8. The Respondent is not under the influence of any drugs or alcohol at the time this document is being signed.
9. The Respondent agrees that there has been sufficient opportunity to consult with legal counsel before signing this document.
10. The Respondent is voluntarily waiving all rights to a contested hearing before the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists.
11. The respondent is voluntarily waiving any right to appeal from any order of the Board entered in conformity to this stipulation.
12. The Respondent agrees that the Order set forth immediately below may be entered by the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists.

Order

13. Based on the above stipulations the Board finds that the parties have agreed that the Board may find the above facts as true and as proving that Respondent has committed unprofessional conduct. The Board so finds.
14. The Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists hereby **WARNS** Respondent's license.
15. The Board orders Respondent to **pay an administrative penalty** of \$500.00 to the Vermont Secretary of State within 60 days of the entry of this order. Failure to do so is a violation of this order.
16. This Stipulation and Consent Order is a matter of public record and may be reported to other licensing authorities as provided in 3 V.S.A. §129(a).
17. This Stipulation and Consent Order will remain part of the Respondent's licensing file and may be used in determining sanctions in future disciplinary matters.
